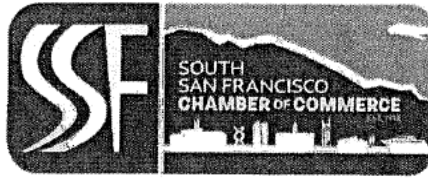

A commercial tax measure projected to collect upwards of \$50 million annually to fund early child care in South San Francisco will appear on the November ballot. The measure is opposed by a majority of the South San Francisco City Council. It is not aligned with the city's childcare master plan. No one is opposed to childcare or the need to expand childcare in South San Francisco. This measure commits nearly 50.0% of the current city's budget to childcare. We, the Chamber of Commerce, want to work with the City of South San Francisco to find a safe, fair, and more equitable way to provide childcare. The South San Francisco Chamber of Commerce is opposed to a special parcel tax on businesses.

Argument Against Measure DD

We need to expand childcare in South San Francisco, but it must be done in a safe, fair, and affordable way. Measure DD is a poorly written mega tax backed by outside interests that puts our children at risk. Vote No on Measure DD.

The City of South San Francisco released a Childcare Master Plan that addresses the needs of children with over 100 recommendations for providing universal, quality, and safe childcare. South San Francisco is already leading the county on childcare issues as one of only two cities with childcare impact fees and the only city to launch a standalone childcare plan. We need to support the City's plan, not a massive tax that won't provide childcare for everyone who needs it nor guarantee preschool for all South San Francisco residents.

Measure DD is unsafe: it states that childcare providers who receive funds do not have to obtain a state license or adhere to health and safety guidelines.

Measure DD won't provide preschool for all: the city's economic report shows that the measure won't even provide enough preschool seats for everyone who needs them.

Measure DD is bad for taxpayers: it has no guidelines or oversight on how money can be spent by providers.

Measure DD is a huge tax: it will raise \$56 million per year – almost half the city's current budget – without addressing some of our most pressing needs, such as affordable housing and public safety.

Measure DD will hurt small businesses: it doesn't just tax large corporations but will also impact minority small businesses like dentists and biotech startups performing critical healthcare work that won't be able to absorb this huge tax forcing them to leave South San Francisco.

We urge you to vote No on this poorly written measure so we can enact a real plan for childcare for South San Francisco.
