

Project Title: Bermuda Drive Bridge Replacement Project

Project Location: Bermuda Drive, between Fiesta Drive and Annapolis Drive

Project Location – City: San Mateo

Project Location – County: San Mateo

Name of Public Agency Approving Project: City of San Mateo

Description of Project: The project is the replacement of the existing, two-lane bridge on Bermuda Drive over Fiesta Channel between Fiesta Drive and Annapolis Drive in the City of San Mateo. The existing two-lane bridge, which was constructed in 1954, is 54-feet long and 60-feet wide. The existing bridge is deteriorated, deemed structurally deficient due to the corrosion of steel pile shells, cracking of the deck slab and masonry walls, and pile extensions that are vulnerable to failure in a significant earthquake which could lead to collapse.


The proposed project is to reconstruct the deficient Bermuda Drive Bridge to maintain a safe route. The reconstruction project will correct the substandard design features of the Bermuda Drive Bridge. The proposed replacement bridge will be a two-span cast-in-place reinforced concrete slab structure, 58-feet and 6-inches long. It will be supported on reinforced concrete diaphragm-type abutments with 18-inch diameter cast-in-steel shell (CISS) pile foundations. Pile steel shells will be installed using the torque-down method within the dewatered channel and at the abutments. Pile depth is estimated to be approximately 82-feet. Wingwalls approximately 8-feet in length will cantilever off the corners of each abutment to provide support and protection of the approach embankments. The replacement bridge will be 60-feet wide, accommodating two 20-feet wide lanes and concrete barriers on each side of the deck. The project would include undergrounding the existing overhead electrical and communication lines at the north end of the bridge to provide clearance for pile installation. A portion of the trench would extend along the approximate top of bank of the channel.

Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project: City of San Mateo Public Works Department

Exempt Status: Class 2, Section 15302, Replacement or Reconstruction: Class 2 consists of the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.

Reasons why Project is Exempt: The project would replace the existing Bermuda Drive Bridge to provide the only vehicular access to the housing development south of the Fiesta Channel. The replacement bridge would serve the same purpose as the existing bridge and would not increase vehicle capacity. The bridge would be constructed according to current Caltrans and AASHTO standards.

Per Section 15300.2 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, it has been determined that the project is not located on a hazardous waste site, would not result in a significant impact due to unusual circumstances, damage scenic resources, affect a historic resource, or result in a cumulative impact. For these reasons and those stated above, the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

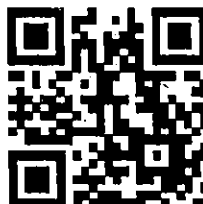
